TREASURER'S REPORT,

GOVERNOR'S REPORT,

The following issues were discussed at the December Governor's meeting,

1. Electric vehicles will be a problem in the coming year. Keep non-corvette elec. autos away from the show corvettes.
2. N.C.C.C. now has approximately 18,000 members.
3. Convention week charge will be \$185.00
4. Tours are now available for the National Corvette Museum.
5. Future Corvette Owners in the East Ohio Region are 102.
6. Any rule book changes need to be in by 3/15/2923
7. 238 clubs in the N.C.C.C.
8. Several possible Regional rule changes were defeated.
9. E.O.R. change approved that Board members must attend at least 3 sanctioned events per year.
10. NCCC Liability Ins. Expires on 12/31/22 there is some uneasiness about coverage for 2023,
11. E.O.R. patches are under review and cost will be reported on at the March meeting.
12. Anyone planning on attending the Regional Banquet should have payment in by 1/31/23. Info is available on Regional WEB site, eornccc.org.
13. Nominations for Regional officer openings start May 2023 and close on 9/1/23 voting on 9/2/23.
