There are 2 parts to our website.

1. The home page is a **“Public”** page. Meaning anyone who visits our website will be able to see what is on this page.
2. There is a **“Members”** page for club members only. This is private information.

You will need to set up your Personal Log In to access the **“Members”** page

Setting up your Personal Log In is a simple process.

1. Open the website
2. Look at the top of the page
3. In the center you will see a **“Member Log In”** button
4. Click on this button and you will be taken to page where you can create your **“User Name”** and **“Password”**.
5. For your User Name, use your email address that you gave the club when you joined.
6. Click on **“Create Password”** and type in your private Password.
7. This Password needs to have Upper and Lowercase letters, a symbol and numbers. The exact number of each is on the Create Password Page.
8. You will be asked to re-type your newly created Password to confirm it.
9. I suggest you save your User Name and Password to your phone, tablet or computer so you don't need to type it in each time you log into our website.

This is a great tool to use if you are out and want to contact one of our members.
